Rise trust CCs – 2 buildings closing but services will still be available in those areas. Currently launching a course where people can volunteer and earn a level 2 qualification in early years at the same time.

Tony Griffin Safeguarding – Course dates in June for Foundation and Advanced Child Protection courses. Please see attached flyers.

Wiltshire Community Foundation – Grants available to groups around Wiltshire. Also grants for individuals for educational purposes.

WPCC – short breaks bulletin has been launched for Easter includes universal and targeted activities. WPCC can help with issues with special school provision changes.

Alabare – Parent and baby project in Salisbury is running for next 2 years for under 25 year old parents that need somewhere to live. 30 hour job vacancy available for someone with early years experience.

Julia's house – Family support services now up and running in Wiltshire.

SPLASH – New contract for 3 years to provide support services to Wiltshire police to support witnesses and victims of crime including counselling, positive activities, coaching, signposting. SPLASH Is now 30 years old. Full Time vacancy coming up in June.

Youth adventure trust – working with two thirds of schools in Wiltshire to provide a youth development programme based on sports and activities. Currently a full-time volunteer manager vacancy

Kooth – Wiltshire age is extending up to 25 as of 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019 until April 2020. Please see attached
